All requirements listed below must be met by a high school student to receive a LVCA

Successful completion of 220 units or its equivalent is required for high school graduation, in addition to successful completion of both sections of the CAHSEE exam. School options for completing each growth area are listed under the growth area. Choose one track for each growth area below:

Reading/Writing

This LVCA graduate reads and writes effectively.
40 Units of Reading/Writing electives

Life Skills

This LVCA graduate sufficiently understands and functions in the world around him.
35 Units including:
10 units Typing/Computer electives
20 units Physical Education electives
5 units Health

History

This LVCA graduate appreciates the history of mankind in all its diversity.
25 Units of History including:
10 units World Studies
10 units US History
5 units Economics

Political Process

This LVCA graduate comprehends the political process.
5 Units United States Government

Mathematics

This LVCA graduate applies math principles and operations to solve problems.
30 Units Mathematics including:
10 units Algebra 1
20 units Mathematics elective

Science

This LVCA graduate applies scientific concepts and skills to explain his world and find solutions to its problems.
20 Units of Science including:
10 units Physical Science elective
10 units Life Science elective

Special Interests/Electives

This LVCA graduate realizes his own special interests, talents and abilities.
A. 60 Units of Electives including:
10 Visual and Performing Arts electives
55 units electives (college academic or vocational)

State Required Assessment

CAHSEE ELA and CAHSEE Math must both be completed with a score of "PASS". Six opportunities to pass are offered during 10th, 11th, and 12th grades.
